SLCS bond work continues on district buildings and facilities

Thanks to the \$98.7 million school improvement bond that residents approved in 2020, South Lyon Community Schools continues to upgrade its buildings to accommodate the growth in enrollment and reimagine existing instructional space. The bond money is also being used to improve student safety and school security; technology infrastructure and equipment upgrades; building updates; and furniture replacement.

Much has been done and much is continuing, despite delays caused by COVID. Here's a rundown of what has been completed, what is in process, and what is still to come.

South Lyon High School

- Mechanical Upgrades, including demolition of multiple existing AHU's, and installation of a new one
- Main Corridor Terrazzo Installation
- Tennis Court Reconstruction
- Drainage Improvements surrounding JV & Varsity Baseball Fields, as well as turf installation at the Varsity Baseball Infield
- Turf installation throughout the Varsity Softball Field

South Lyon East High School

- Auxiliary Gym Construction ongoing
- Two new classrooms created within the previously occupied Foods Lab
- Renovations to two of the existing Planning Studios

Millenium Middle School

- New asphalt parking lots and select concrete improvements

Bartlett Elementary School

- Office Renovations
- Media Center Flooring Replacement
- Gym Hallway Upgrades
- Gym Storage Upgrades
- Basketball Court Installation
- New Addition work for the 4-Classroom addition is underway

Sayre Elementary School

- Office Renovations and Flooring Replacement
- New Collaboration Room within the Media Center

Dolsen Elementary School

- Window Replacements throughout the building
- Roller Shade Installation at all new windows
- Office Renovations

Early Childhood Center

- Parking Lot Replacement has already been completed

Kent Lake, Bartlett, and ECC

- Removal of select playground equipment, and installation of various new playground equipment across all three sites
