* Above are the minimum grade requirements to be eligible for extra-curricular activities.

* Remember... eligibility is established at the semester with a 1.7 GPA and no semester 'E's. If eligibility is not established the student will not be allowed to participate for a minimum of 6 weeks. After that 6 weeks the student must re-establish eligibility with a 1.7 and no 'E's or they will remain ineligible.

* Incoming Freshman begin the year as eligible. Their first evaluation comes at the end of MP 1. All current students will be evaluated from the prior semester.
