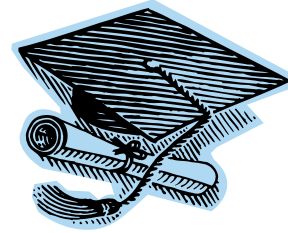

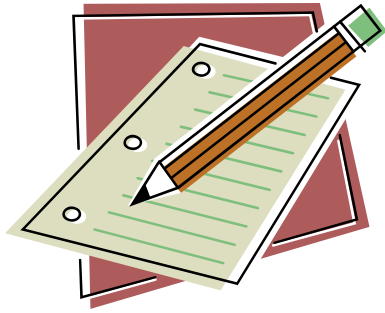

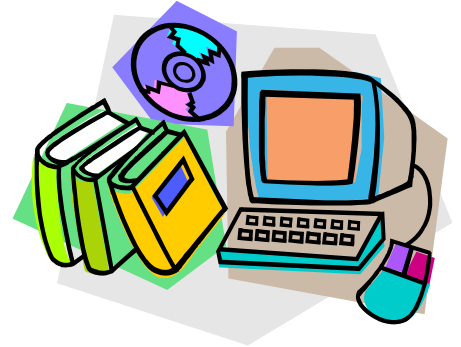

## Recommended Materials for all CMS Math Classes 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade levels: 2011-2012



- 3-ring binder, at least 1 1/2 inches this binder should **not** be used for other courses.
- Set of 5 divider tabs
- Pencil Case for binder
- Pencils / Erasers
- Lined Paper
- Graph Paper (1/4 inch grid lines)
- **Jumbo** Book Cover - All math books **MUST** be covered and "One Size fits All do not fit our books"
- Ruler (for use at home)
- Colored Pencils (for use at home)
- Calculator (for use at home)



### Calculator Recommendation



Students will be provided with the necessary calculators while they work in class. However, many students find it helpful to have their own calculators at home and some students even prefer to bring their own calculators to class. Our district supplies students with Texas Instruments calculators for classroom use. Should you wish to purchase a calculator for your child, any graphing calculator at or above the level of a TI-73 should work through high school.

Algebra students often find it helpful to have a calculator that is capable of doing square roots since that is a unit of study in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Scientific and graphing calculators both contain this function. We use the TI-84 Plus Silver Edition in our Algebra classrooms.

Please note that the TI-92 (the kind with a keyboard similar to that of a computer) and other like calculators are NOT allowed on standardized tests such as the MEAP, the ACT, or the SAT. Therefore, we do not recommend or allow those types of calculators.
