Yesterday, Michigan Attorney General Schuette was at a school presentation in the Cadillac school district and shared the following comment: “Unfortunately, we know that just because school is out for the summer does not mean that students are free from bullying or thoughts of self-harm, just to name a few,” said Schuette. “This is why I remind students and schools every year that OK2SAY is still accepting tips all through
