 - 8th Grade DC Trip fundraising accounts
 - Current 8th Graders
 1. Fundraising deadline was January 1, 2017
 2. If an 8th grade family has fundraised over the amount they paid out of pocket for their total payment, a refund only of amount the family paid out of pocket will be offered.
 - a. Those families will have the choice to receive a refund or donate to the DC financial aid fund
 - ii. Current 7th Graders
 1. Fundraising deadline will be January 1, 2018
 2. If after deadline a family has fundraised over amount paid out of pocket for their total payment, a refund only of amount the family paid out of pocket will be offered
 - a. Those families will have the choice to receive a refund or donate to the DC financial aid fund
 - iii. Current 6th graders and future Millennium 6th graders
 1. Fundraising accounts will begin July 1st of the summer before their 6th grade year
 2. Fundraising deadline will be at the end of 7th grade. June of 7th grade will be the last month to fundraise.
