1. President(Joan Herrinton)- Meeting called to order at 7:05 PM
2. Treasurer's Report(Sandy Miller)- Year to date profit on Cougar Closet of \$611, formal wear sale brought in a profit of \$360.36, Applebee's Pancake breakfast brought in profit of \$115.00. Directory sales brought in a little more in Sept and we received \$40 for vendors during the Taste of Homecoming.
3. Cougar Closet(Sue Crittendon)- Demographics are such that the directory presales will happen during the taste of homecoming as well as the store being open for business. During the taste of homecoming the Cougar Closet will sell East water bottles for \$4 with hot chocolate in them. Sue and Mr. Robinson (art teacher) are setting up a program through the Closet which will feature student artwork for sale in which the student will receive 50% and the Closet will receive the other 50% on the sale of any art work.
4. Formal Wear Sale (Sandy Miller and Karen Timm)- sold 53 dresses, 1 man's suit, several purses, shoes, and shawls. It was suggested that for further events the split on the sales will be changed. Thinking this event will happen in the spring for prom and more solid guidelines will be set up for what will be accepted by when and in what condition. Suggested for advertising to use Oakpointe and Northridge as well as local radio stations.
5. Electronic Sign- meeting will happen on Wed. Oct. 15 with Mike Casey about the progress and such.
6. Taste of Homecoming (Florence Kasper)- Have a good base of volunteers for the event on Fri Oct. 9. Touching base with all the vendors to finalize. Had a presale to the large groups like (cheer, band....) of about 100 people. We will sell tickets during the parade (there will be ticket sales people walking around the crowds). Mr. Jackson is checking into the use of the gym for Fri Taste of Homecoming if rain is forecast. The call on location for the event will be made earlier in the day. Bush's has donated 480 bottles of water as well as Walmart (\$50 gift card) and Costco(\$25 gift card). Tents and round tables are set for the event. Advertising has been done. Entertainment- bungie run, football throw, cotton candy. Decorating- Shelly is bringing balloons. Set up- Florence is sending out email to volunteers (park in lower lot 385-405 lower parking lot). Supplies- Florence and Sandy are working on shopping for items.
7. Student Parking Lot concerns- Concerns over the light and it's quickness on changing which doesn't allow for very many to exit the premises and may cause some students to drive more carelessly. It has been observed that student's are driving across the parking lights and not stopping at stop signs to get out of the parking lot faster.
