

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT

The Board supports the concept of school improvement as established by the State Board of Education and will seek to create and/or maintain effective schools as defined by State guidelines.

In addition to adopting a Mission Statement and Educational Philosophy for the District, the Board shall create, as needed, policies which support the School Improvement Process.

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall establish administrative guidelines which will ensure that the following objectives can be achieved:

- A. School improvement plans will be developed and implemented by school-based teams that work collaboratively, so that both building level and District level goals for students can be identified and correlated. These will be achieved through effective planning, problem-solving, and assessment. Each such team is to include school stake holders as defined by Board policy.
- B. Plans will be shared annually with building Shared Involvement Process (S.I.P.) Teams and will meet state, federal and NCA requirements.
