

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The quality of curriculum and the use of instructional materials in the school are vital factors in education. Provisions and guidelines must be made for the continual review and evaluation of existing curriculum, through the use of the curriculum and instructional mapping to align with the standards established by the Michigan Department of Education and the Board. Curriculum maps will include an AYP column used to identify grade level content expectations needing extra emphasis with a focus on closing achievement gaps.

The CITA Curriculum Development Plan shall be utilized to review, evaluate and purchase all curriculum and instructional media. The process for selection of curriculum and materials shall include review to detect any bias based on any legally protected interest.
