

ADOPTION OF COURSES OF STUDY

The Board is responsible for the total school program. The actual development of curriculum, including courses of study and assessments, and the selection of instructional materials are the responsibility of the Assistant Superintendent of CITA directed by the Superintendent. Subject Area Committees (SAC) will assist the Assistant Superintendent of CITA with the organization, development, implementation, review and revision of the overall curriculum, including assessments, in advance of the school year in which the courses are to become operative. The Assistant Superintendent of CITA shall submit all curricular assessments and instructional recommendations to the Superintendent who will make recommendations to the Board for their adoption. New or revised curriculum will be shared with appropriate building SIP committees. Curriculum, including assessments and materials for designated subject areas and levels, adopted by the Board shall be implemented consistently across the District and assessment results shall be used to inform instruction. It is the responsibility of the building principal to monitor the implementation of this policy.
