

INSTRUCTIONAL PRACTICES

It shall be the policy of the Board to place in the hands of administrators and teachers the responsibility to provide appropriate instruction which addresses the varied learning strengths and needs of individual and groups of students and promotes continuous improvement of student learning. Professional staff, under the leadership of the principal, shall take responsibility for delivering instructional services which are aligned with the district's mission, guiding principles and district curriculum objectives/benchmarks with a focus on closing achievement gaps. These instructional services shall also be delivered in a manner compatible with these policies/rules and in cooperation with the Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent for CITA.

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
