

BOARD NEGOTIATING AGENTS

The Superintendent may choose to serve as chief negotiator, or he/she shall appoint a member of the staff, or an outside consultant, to serve as chief negotiator in negotiations with each employee group recognized under the Public Employment Relations Act.

The Superintendent may appoint other members(s) of the administrative staff to each negotiating team to assist and counsel the chief negotiator.

The appointed chief negotiator shall be fully empowered to reach a tentative agreement on collective bargaining agreements on behalf of the Board within the parameters established by the Board.
