

SUPERINTENDENT'S ROLE IN NEGOTIATIONS

The Superintendent may serve as the chief negotiator for the Board. If the Superintendent is not serving as the chief negotiator, he/she may serve as a negotiating team member or as a consultant to the negotiating team.

The Superintendent shall serve as the liaison between the Board and the bargaining team and shall be responsible for keeping the Board informed on the progress of negotiations.

The Superintendent shall arrange for the chief negotiator to meet with the Board to develop negotiation goals and objectives, establish parameters and provide updates on the progress of negotiations.
