

SCHOOL BOUNDARIES

The Board realizes the stability of the educational process is important for our schools and community. Redistricting will occur only when data deems it necessary. The administration will monitor and keep the Board informed of data such as student population trends, classroom usage, and school of choice students. When it becomes apparent that redistricting may need to occur, based on administrative recommendation, the Board will initiate a redistricting study.

The Board shall then determine the school attendance areas of the District and shall expect the students within each area to attend the school so designated, unless covered by School of Choice options or other conditions established by the Board. During elementary redistricting, any fifth grade student, but only fifth grade students, will be considered for a grandfathering option to remain at their previously assigned building. Transportation would be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Any attempt to falsify residency information will be investigated and may result in the student being sent back to his/her designated school.

No assignment to schools or attendance schedules shall discriminate against students on the basis of disability, religion, race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, height, weight, or generally in violation of any State or Federal law.

The principal shall assign students in his/her school to appropriate grades, classes, or programs.
