

FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

The Board acknowledges that "fundraisers" may provide additional support to the educational system and community. The Board will permit fundraising in school, on school property, or at any school-sponsored event only when the profit therefrom is to be used for school purposes or for an activity connected with and approved by the schools. All fundraising projects must be approved in advance by the building principal in writing.

The following are categories of fundraising which are permitted:

1. Solicitation of funds from students by student organizations.
2. Solicitation of funds from students by District recognized parent/teacher groups or organizations. Examples include, but are not limited to, PTO, Booster organizations, etc.
3. Fundraising for philanthropic purposes by student organizations only.
4. Group fundraising events sponsored by student organizations and/or District recognized parent/teacher groups or organizations.

The Administration shall establish administrative guidelines for the solicitation of funds.

All monies collected by members of the staff are to be turned in daily to the main office or other secured location as determined by administration.

The principal shall distribute this policy and the guidelines which implement it to each organization granted permission to solicit funds.
