

PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS

The Board recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through participation and performances in public events.

The Board endorses such performances when:

- A. they constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational program;
- B. the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety, and well-being of the students who will be involved.

All requests for public performances by students require the approval of the principal.

The Administration shall develop administrative guidelines to implement this policy which include the requirement that parental permission is sought and received before students participate, that students have met the eligibility requirements of the Extracurricular/Co-Curricular Activity Program Participation Board Policy, and that the interests of our students are to be protected and guarded against exploitation.
