

**ATHLETIC, CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR
ACTIVITIES FUNDING**

The Board realizes the importance of athletic and extra-curricular activities to students and as a supplement to the educational program of the District. The Board has established standards and processes for full and/or partial funding of District recognized athletic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Co-curricular activities are those associated with a school class that require a student to participate in any capacity in a public performance or to serve as a representative of South Lyon Community Schools as a component of assessment for the class. Extra-curricular activities do not require public performance or participation as a component of assessment for a class.

District recognized athletic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are listed in Schedule C of the Master Agreement between the South Lyon Education Association and the Board of Education of the South Lyon Community School District.

The following will be funded:

- Stipends for District recognized athletic, co-curricular and extra-curricular coaches and sponsors included in the annual budget and in accordance with Schedule C.

The following may be funded at the discretion of the building/department administration:

- An annual competitive speech program.
- In-state athletic entry fees and co-curricular/extra-curricular registration fees for competitions through the State level.
- MHSAA compliant athletic entry fees and co-curricular/extra-curricular registration fees for one-day, out-of-state trips.
- In-state transportation by school bus to regular scheduled and invitational high school and middle school athletic contests, district/state athletic tournaments, co-curricular and extra-curricular practices and events.
- Transportation by school bus to one-day out-of-state athletic contests, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- Athletic, extra-curricular and co-curricular state finals overnight lodging expenses.
- Co-curricular and extra-curricular in-State miscellaneous fees.

The following will not be funded:

- Out-of-state athletic, co-curricular and extra-curricular transportation, registration fees and other expenses for trips of more than one day.
- In-state extra-curricular travel that is not required as part of the program.

- Any 5th grade camp expenses, including transportation; however, professional compensation is paid in accordance with Schedule C.
- Co-curricular and extra-curricular competitions beyond the State level.
- Extra and co-curricular camps including band, choir, sports, etc.

Options for Non-Funded Activities:

- Coaches/sponsors, Parent/Teacher organizations, students and parents involved in athletic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities may fundraise following Board Policy 6610 in order to fund these expenses.
- With district notification and approval, parent/teacher organizations may choose to help fund volunteer and both Schedule C and non Schedule C organizations.
