

ENERGY USE AND CONSERVATION POLICY

PURPOSE

The South Lyon Community Schools is committed to promoting the efficient use of all natural resources required by the District. In keeping with this commitment, the District shall provide leadership in developing a responsible energy use ethic.

STATEMENT OF POLICY

The District's success in achieving an effective energy use, conservation and efficiency program requires and depends upon cooperation at all levels. Therefore, every employee, student, school volunteer, contractor, and community member is encouraged to, contribute to and actively participate in, the District's energy management program, and to be an "energy saver" as well as an "energy consumer."

POLICY SUPPORT

The Board hereby directs the Administration to develop guidelines in support of this policy as well as the development of an Energy Management Program. This program will direct the District in the efficient operation of its facilities, while maintaining a safe and healthy learning environment for students and staff. The program should include, but not be limited to, guidelines which will regulate the operation of energy-use systems, an incentive program to promote energy savings in school buildings, educational information to staff and other stakeholders, records of energy consumption and energy costs, and periodic reports providing feedback and progress regarding program initiatives.
