

USE OF TOBACCO ON SCHOOL PREMISES

The District supports the Tobacco-Free Schools Law, which prohibits use of tobacco products in District buildings or on school property at any time.

Staff, students or any other persons may not use tobacco products at any time in any District building or on school property owned or operated by the South Lyon Community School District.

The use of tobacco products by any persons in violation of this policy will result in disciplinary action. Violation of the Tobacco-Free Schools Law is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00.
