

CONTROL OF CASUAL CONTACT COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

In order to protect the health and safety of students, District personnel, and the community at large, the Board shall follow all State statutes and Oakland County Health Department regulations which pertain to immunization and other means for controlling communicable disease spread through normal interaction in the school setting.

The Superintendent, or his/her designee, shall develop administrative guidelines for the control of communicable disease which shall include:

- A. instruction of professional staff members in the detection of these common diseases and measures for their prevention and control;
- B. removal of students from District property to the care of a responsible adult;
- C. preparation of standards for the readmission of students who have recovered from casual contact communicable diseases;
- D. filing of reports as required by statute and the Health Department.
- E. providing students and families with information regarding prevention of the spread of communicable diseases in the school setting as needed.
