Budget Update

- Corrections have not yet been posted for the Restorative Processes misallocation of salary. Ms. Altermatt will follow up.
- Problems with billing have been found in the copier account. This is being investigated at the district level. Ms. Altermatt will follow up.
- Ms. Altermatt shared that principals have been informed that costs have not yet been completely allocated for the phone accounts. She will follow up on this as well.
- A revised 2010-2011 budget was shared with SIP. Changes reflected the list of priorities established by the committee earlier this year. SIP members endorsed the budget as presented.
- Ms. Altermatt explained that carryover funds could be used to continue to fund our use of Restorative Processes. We will be able to have the program two days per week next year; the facilitator will be shared with SLHS and East.
- At this time, we cannot afford to fund Challenge Day next year. We will review other options for conducting a similar program in-house.
