New SIP Member: Nancy Kirchoff was introduced as new parent representative.

School Improvement Goals Update: L. Jackson stated that the SLHS goals have been reviewed by the NCA and a letter has been received stating that the goals are in full compliance with NCA expectations. Committees continue to meet once a month and are now working to achieve those goals. Are still expecting the first NCA Chairperson visit soon.

Tardy Policy Committee: The draft Attendance Policy formulated by this committee was presented and S. Massuch asked for comments or questions representatives had heard from constituents. Based on input received, several modifications to the policy were agreed upon. Motion to approve the policy as amended made by R. Weber, seconded by K. Schlang. Motion approved. D. Beagle will incorporate the changes into a final draft and email it to L. Jackson tonight for distribution to staff for comment.

Student Handbook Revisions: A new attendance policy will necessitate several changes to the Handbook, as follows:

- The new policy will be added as item “B. Attendance Policy” under School Procedures
- Old item “B. Absence Guidelines” will become item C.
- Policy “NN. Tardiness” will be deleted from the Student Code of Conduct and all subsequent policies will be re-lettered.

No additional changes to the Handbook are necessary at this time.

Motion to approve the recommended Handbook changes made by R. Swain, seconded by N. Kirchoff. Motion approved.

Freshman Athletes: S. Massuch received a question from a parent concerning the placement of freshman athletes on a varsity team when a freshman and/or JV team is available in that sport. L. Jackson stated that this issue is not a SIP matter and will be referred to the Athletic Department.
