Meeting called to order at 2:49 pm by Chairperson K. Schlang

**Approval of Agenda:** Motion to approve agenda as presented made by R. Swain, seconded by N. Kirchoff. Motion approved.

**SIP Survey:** L. Jackson stated that the survey was mailed to all SLHS parents. Cover letter briefly explained the SIP Committee and asked for feedback. Survey will be emailed to all SLHS staff. Surveys will be available in the main office for students to obtain. Completed surveys will be collected by R. Weber, analyzed and results presented at the May SIP meeting. Based on results from last year's survey, which indicated that SIP information needs to be more effectively communicated to staff and students, minutes from this year's meetings have been scrolled on the classroom tv's. Will examine feedback from this year's survey to see if this helped disseminate SIP information as was intended. S. Zimmerman suggested that there be a SIP Committee table with information available at Open House and Parent/Teacher Conferences. Members agreed and will set this up for next fall's open house.

**MEAP Chart Data:** L. Jackson presented graphs which compared the percentages of students receiving proficient scores compared to those not proficient for reading, science, math and social studies. The overall trend shows the percentages of SLCS students receiving proficient scores increasing while the percentages of students receiving not proficient scores decreasing. Some subjects and grade levels have shown dramatic improvements in MEAP scores. Data indicate the SLCS curriculum and the efforts by teachers to help all students master the curriculum are working.

**New Band Director:** Question was raised as to criteria and timeline for hiring new director. L. Jackson stated the position was posted this week and goal is to have a director hired by late May/early June. Reservations have been made for band camp and student sign-up is progressing with current director. New director will be responsible for selecting section leaders and drum major for next year.
