**General Announcements**

- Juniors theme for Prom this year is "Treasure the Night". Recognition was given to Jenny Davis for her amazing design of the 2010 prom ticket. Jenny also was the Drug Free Schools Poster Contest winner for SLHS.

**Old/New Business**

- Ms. DelVecchio shared that the Crisis Team now has a draft plan in place.
- Mr. Webber spoke to Sue Sullivan, Food Service Manager, and they have worked together to begin the process of incorporating more whole grains and nutritional choices in the lunch menu. Mrs. Schlang shared an article on obesity with the committee.
- Mr. Rosekrans reviewed the District Improvement Plan. The format for this report has been changed by the state and is required to be completed by all districts. This is a comprehensive 5-year plan on what our school will be doing to meet the three goals in Math, Writing, and reading.
- Ms. DelVecchio passed out the book, *Teach Like a Champion*, to the committee. All of the teachers received a copy of this book at their last staff meeting. Mr. Rosekrans commented that this book offers essential tools of the teaching craft so that teachers are able to unlock the talent and skill of their students. He said that this was a must-have resource for all teachers.
- Student Council stated that Pride Week was not as successful as they had hoped for. They felt there were gaps in communication and marketing that need to be addressed for next year. However, they are hopeful that this can be corrected and look forward to next year's event. A few suggestions were made to make improvements for next year including considering a change of date so more students are able to attend. Compliments were given to EAST students for their first "EAST Week" which included a student/staff "pom" routine, the "Experience" concert and a carnival. Ms. Del Vecchio noted that several SLHS students attended the concert as well.
- Mr. Rosekrans discussed the new idea of the SLHS PRIDE (Positive Relationships Intended to Deliver Excellence) mentor program. Teachers were given applications and asked to announce this new program to their students. All students who would be juniors or seniors for the 2010-2011 school year that were interested, were encouraged to pick up an application and return it by May 6<sup>th</sup>. They will be holding mentor meetings on June 3<sup>rd</sup> and August 25<sup>th</sup>. Freshman Orientation and Registration will be held on August 26<sup>th</sup>.

- The SIP Survey was given to members of the SIP committee. Ms. DelVecchio asked the committee if there were any changes or additions they would like to make. All teachers will be given a copy of the survey to fill out in the next few weeks with results provided to SIP at the next meeting.
