**Important information to know:**

- For yearlong courses earning high school credit, both semesters will be assessed at the same time in one assessment during the June testing out window.
- A student must pass (earn 78% or better) in order to earn credit and in the case of a sequence of courses, to enroll in the next course.
- When possible, students are assigned to sections containing their same grade level peers. Middle school students who test out of 6<sup>th</sup> grade math, 7<sup>th</sup> grade math or Algebra I and reside in the Centennial boundary will attend MMS for their full school day in order to participate with grade level peers enrolled in the Plus courses.
- All middle school students who successfully test out of Geometry and aim to take a course at one of our high schools will need to complete a separate form. Please contact the school office if you need this form.
