



## Summer Kids Club FAQ



**What time are you open?** We are open from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.

**How will I access the building?** Summer Kids Club is held at the Early Childhood Center (310 N. Warren). You will receive **two** green fobs (at no charge) that you can use for the summer to access the ECC. During the first week of Kids Club there will be a table set up as you enter the front doors of the building where you will fill out a fob agreement and sign out your fobs.

**Do you provide lunch?** On most days we do not provide lunch. We ask that you send a sack lunch with your child each day. We are not able to refrigerate or warm up lunches. Special lunch days will be shared with you ahead of time.

**Do you provide snacks?** Yes, we do provide a morning and an afternoon snack.

**Do I need to send a Water Bottle?** Yes, please send a labeled water bottle with your child **each day**.

**What is your dress code?** Children will be playing inside and outside. We ask that they have play clothes on as well as closed toed shoes and socks. Please refrain from sending your child in sandals and flip flops. Feel free to send an extra set of clothes in your child's backpack in case they get wet or have an extra messy art day.

**Does my child need sunscreen?** Yes, we ask that you provide a bottle of sunscreen (non-aerosol) with your child's name on it. You will be asked to fill out a sunscreen permission slip form on the first day of Summer Kids Club.

**Do I need to sign my child in and out of Summer Kids Club every day?** Yes, for your child's safety, Summer Kids Club and the State of Michigan require that children must be signed **in and out** of the program by a parent/guardian or a person listed on your child's emergency card.

**Can my child take medication while in Summer Kids Club?** Yes, if your child will need a prescribed medication, the district's "Authorization for Medication" form must be signed by your doctor and given to your room leader. If you have an existing form already on file at your child's school, please ask for a copy in the office. Your medication must be in the original prescription package or bottle (with the prescription label intact), or it will not be accepted.

**Will I be billed for Vacation Days?** The number of vacation days received equals the number of days per week your child is registered for Summer Kids Club times two. For example, if your child attends Summer Kids Club all five days, you receive ten vacation days.

### Field Trip Information

- Children will receive a Summer Kids Club t-shirt to be worn on field trips so the group will be easily identifiable. Each classroom dyes their shirts a different color the first week of Summer Kids Club.
- Specific information about field trips will be provided on our summer calendar which will be shared the first day of Summer Kids Club
- Departure times will be listed on the summer calendar. Please arrive to Summer Kids Club **before** the departure time so your child can get settled, put on their field trip t-shirt, and apply sunscreen. We will not hold buses and arrive late to a scheduled trip to wait for families who are not on time.
- On field trip days no staff will be in the building to care for late drop offs or children who need to leave early.
