

SCHOOLS OF CHOICE
(Intra-District)

Intra-District Schools of Choice (SOC) is open to all students at the elementary level.

Siblings in a family with a child in a self-contained special education program at CMS and/or SLHS may also attend CMS and/or SLHS even if it is not their boundary school.

For 2016-17 only, as a transition to potential redistricting and to help alleviate overcrowding at CMS, incoming students in grades 6, 7, or 8 will be allowed a SOC option from CMS to MMS only. These students would be allowed to remain at MMS throughout middle school.

Students who are entering grades 7 or 8 in the 2017-18 school year only, and who were affected by redistricting, may choose to remain at their previous school through the end of their 8th grade year, using the SOC option.

There are no other secondary intra-district SOC options.

Any other deviations from this policy are determined by the Board. The Superintendent or his/her designee shall specify the conditions under which a student may enroll in a school other than the one in his/her attendance area.

In all cases, except the following, transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian:

1. On a space available basis, transportation may be provided by the school district for an intra-district school of choice sibling of a student whose IEP requires them to attend a school other than their home boundary school.
2. For 2017-18 and 2018-19 only (during the redistricting transition period), transportation will be provided for middle school Intra-district SOC students.

Any attempt to falsify residency information will be investigated and may result in the student being sent back to his/her designated school.
