She has served in the capacity of Business Development and most recently as Manager of Patient Access for short-term treatment facilities (addiction and psych hospitals). She currently serves as President Pro Tempore on the Board of Directors for the MAADAC (Michigan Association of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors). She is trained in auricular acupuncture and as a Structured Family Recovery consultant by Debra Jay of Love First.
