

**SOUTH LYON COMMUNITY SCHOOLS
NONRESIDENT SCHOOLS OF CHOICE GUIDELINES
2017-2018 School Year**

Application Procedure

1. Beginning February 27, 2017 applications will be taken for 9th graders at South Lyon East High School. There are also limited elementary spaces--1 Kindergarten space each at Brummer, Kent Lake and Bartlett Elementary schools with priority given to siblings of current Schools of Choice students.
2. All applications will be screened for accurate information. This may involve contacting the former school district.
3. You will be notified of your building assignment no later than August 21, 2017.
4. Your acceptance is conditional until South Lyon Community Schools receives and reviews all school reports.
5. Once accepted, students may remain in South Lyon Community Schools until graduation if the student complies with all guidelines for schools of choice.

Athletics

A secondary student athlete participating in the schools of choice option is not eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics for one full semester as defined and governed by the Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA).

Attendance

Students are expected to arrive and depart from school on time. Students who are excessively absent or tardy could be asked to return to their home district. It is expected that parents will pick up students on time when they are attending an after school or evening event.

Code of Student Conduct

All Code of Student Conduct rules, procedures and policies will apply to all students who enter South Lyon Community Schools under the schools of choice guidelines and procedures.

Redistricting

If the need arises to change the boundaries of any school for the purpose of redistricting students, those students who registered as schools of choice students could be the first students asked to transfer to another school in South Lyon Community Schools.

Transportation

Parents of schools of choice students must provide transportation to and from school.

Timelines

Application Deadline: September 8, 2017 (First Friday of school year)

Enrollment must be completed no later than September 8, 2017. If enrollment is not completed by September 9, the space for your child will be forfeited.

Special Education-Section 105C

The district must have a separate written agreement with the student's district of residence regarding the responsibility of payment of added costs prior to enrollment under Section 105C (student's from a contiguous county ISD).
