Several families have requested that we supply them with a list of grade level recommended supplies over the summer for their “back to school shopping.” Several parents have shared that the best sales for school supplies occur over the summer and that they would like to purchase these supplies prior to the start of school. Our teachers worked together in grade level teams to create this *Recommended Supply List*. Please remember that these items are recommended and **NOT** required. Happy Shopping!

### Kindergarten Community Items Do not label these items.

- 3 Elmer’s glue bottles
- 6 glue sticks
- 6 Crayola 24 pack of crayons
- 2 dry erase erasers
- 3 packs dry erase markers -any color
- Ziploc baggies (snack, sandwich or gallon)
- Kleenex
- 4 Clorox Bleach Wipes
- Playdough
- 1 washable stamp pad
- 2 highlighters
- 3 pks ABC stickers (not foam)
- Any art supplies (pompoms, ribbon, glitter glue, cotton balls, etc.)

### 3rd Grade

- 4 black-marble composition notebooks
- 1 box 10-count markers
- 1 box tissue
- 1 pair Fiskars blunt tip scissors
- Glue sticks
- 5 duotang pocket folders: red, yellow, green, blue, and purple
- 1 packs of loose leaf notebook paper
- #2 pencils (12 count package)
- 24 ct. crayons
- 1 pk dry erase markers
- Backpack without wheels
- Papermate pens—different colors
- Color post-it notes
- Highlighters
- 3 Clorox Bleach Wipes
- 1 set of computer headphones

### 1st Grade

- Crayons—24 count box
- Glue Sticks (lots!!!)
- Scissors—blunt tip
- Erasers (lots)
- **Black** Dry erase markers and erasers
- ONE HEAVY DUTY folder for a take home folder (label it!)
- 4 Folders—Sturdy plastic coated (red, blue, green and yellow)
- **Yellow** Highlighters
- Three (100 sheet) black & white marbled composition books
- One 100 sheet wide ruled spiral notebook—not loose leaf paper
- Standard size pencil box—plastic
- Glue bottles

- ONE (1/2”) binder w/plastic cover to slide a paper cover into
- Blue or black pens
- Backpack—no wheels
- Kleenex
- Clorox/Baby wipes

**\*Please label your child’s pencil box and fill it with a pair of scissors, one glue stick, crayons, and 3-4 sharpened pencils. If you purchase additional items, please send them in and they will be treated as a classroom donation. Label their binder and notebooks as well. Do not label folders or composition books.**
