Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2017-2018 educational progress for South Lyon East High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2017-18 school year, schools were identified using new definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Our school has not been given one of these labels.

We continue to focus on narrowing our achievement gap at South Lyon East High School. We will continue to emphasize high quality instruction and building positive student relationships, as these have a direct and significant impact on student achievement. Additionally, our alignment with the Common Core State Standards will help to maintain our high level of academic rigor.

State law requires that we also report the following additional information:

Student Assignment

All students within the South Lyon Community School district are assigned to schools based upon residency within the geographic boundaries as determined by central office. South Lyon East High School is a "school of choice" (under section 105 and 105C) for students who live outside of South Lyon and want to receive an exceptional education from South Lyon Community Schools.



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School Improvement Plan

South Lyon East High School offers a broad range of learning opportunities. Through a highly qualified and professional staff, we are firm in our resolve to meet the academic needs of our students. As we design our programs, taking into consideration best practices, we continually strive to meet and exceed the performance standards set by AdvancED. At the present time, we are progressing through the third full year of our most recent review cycle.

In December of the 2015-16 school year, South Lyon East High School hosted our most recent scheduled External Review. From the observations, review of our documentation, discussions and the various meetings with stakeholders, the External Review team compiled an Accreditation Report that included two recommendations for improvement as well as recommendation for full accreditation. The administration and staff have broken down the recommendations from the external review team and continue to address the action for improvement. At this time, we have taken action to address areas of improvement as follows:

Improvement Priority #1:

- For the 2016-17 school year, we created an Improvement Priority Framework to help us determine how to develop a systemic method for implementing and developing innovative instructional practices throughout the building rather than in pockets as stated in the review. This included collaborative leadership teams which focused on effective practices, culture and climate, instructional rounds, interventions, data analysis, and research and development. From our culture and climate work, it was determined that staff wanted and needed a systematic method for researching and developing innovative teaching practices.
- During the 2016-17 school year, our instructional rounds team engaged in training through our ISD regarding instructional rounds and how to implement them in a building and at the district level. This initiative was implemented to search for and identify patterns of best practice as well as problems of practice.
- For the 2017-18 school year, we set aside 20% of our staff development time for teachers to engage in personalized professional development "genius hour" time. Staff will use this time to research effective practices and prepare projects for implementation in classrooms. We will create a symposium at the end of the year for teachers to share their work and report on its development. This work will continue in the years to come.
- During the 2017-18 school year, the Instructional rounds team set up a framework for doing rounds in classrooms and are currently looking for patterns in instructional techniques. We hope to eventually engage the entire building in this practice before our next review. Additionally, we continue to engage in training regarding Cultures of Thinking and the use of Visible Thinking skills in our classrooms. Due to large turnover in staff, we have our rounds on hold for the 2018-19 school year, but continue to encourage co-teaching teams as well as gen ed staff, to observe others.



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Improvement Priority #2:

- For the 2016-17 school year, our data team participated in a data use workshop with our ISD and we began to implement a data dialogue framework for the 2017-18 school year. We continued to use this dialogue process using SAT data and year-end and mid-year assessment data in 2018-19 as well.
- Teachers regularly use data from formative assessments in classrooms and our teacher evaluation platform requires that teachers consistently evaluate student understanding using a growth based model. This platform is reviewed each year and teachers receive lesson feedback and dialogue with administration about whether students are meeting daily learning goals.
- Each year, teachers also create growth goals for 25 of their struggling learners to track their growth toward specific skill areas and received training on how to write and manage their goals for the past two years.
- Each year, through our MTSS process, teachers reflect on student performance data and articulate with grade level content areas to dialogue regarding support strategies for students. We are in the process of revising this process at the district level.

South Lyon East High School enjoys a very positive reputation from our community, as well as among school districts throughout the state. We are enthused about continuing this process as we closely monitor the data for student achievement, develop additional strategies/activities, and the eventual success of our goals through our students.

Specialized Schools

Specialized schools are those supported by the district for a specific purpose and with specific criteria for admission. These specialized schools include the Oakland Schools Technical Center (OSTC), the International Academy - West Campus, and the OSTC TEC, and ACE programs.

OSTC is a valuable extension of our high school and brings our students customized self-directed learning that guides them toward future career successes. Students find career direction and fulfill high school graduation requirements, as well as earn industry based-certifications to immediately pursue a career. The OSTC program offers specialized curriculum in nine nationally recognized career clusters that are developed around broad occupational areas. Each career cluster provides concentrated learning through different, yet related, career options.

We recently adopted the OSTC TEC and ACE programs as options for our students interested in enrolling in an early college program. Students who participate in these programs work toward an Associate's Degree in a technical or other field, or to upon completion of these programs, students will have the potential to earn up to 62 college credits before transferring to a university.



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The International Academy (IA) is a public, tuition-free high school of choice for students in Oakland County in collaboration with universities and business partners. Commencing with the ninth grade, students receive a unique blend of rigorous academic standards, practical and career related learning, as well as personal development opportunities. Students at the IA earn an International Baccalaureate diploma.

Core Curriculum

The Michigan K-12 Academic Standards serve as the basis for South Lyon Community Schools' curriculum. To guide continuous improvement, this work is facilitated by the district's curriculum coordinators in collaboration with teachers serving on the Subject Area Curriculum Committees to engage in an ongoing process to ensure alignment with the Michigan Standards in ELA, Mathematics, Science, and Social studies. Parent-Teacher Conferences

South Lyon East High School believes that the education of every student is a shared responsibility between the school and home. We encourage parents, teachers, and students to discuss progress on a regular basis. Report cards, phone calls, e-mails, freshman orientation, volunteerism, and parent-teacher conferences are just a few of the opportunities for direct contact with the school. For the 2015-16, South Lyon East averaged 28% of students represented at our annual curriculum night in October and averaged 41% of parents attended Parent-Student-Teacher conferences. For the 2016-17 school year 27% of students were represented at curriculum night and 41% of our parents attended Parent-Student-Teacher Conferences. For the 2017-18 school year, 27% of students were represented at curriculum night, and 42% of the students were represented at Parent-Student-Teacher conferences. For the 2018-19 school year, 32.23% of students were represented at Curriculum Night, and 38.38% were represented at Parent Teacher Conferences.



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College Equivalent Courses

We provide our students with twelve enrichment courses to challenge them by using their unique talents and abilities. Students in the tenth, eleventh and twelfth grade have the opportunity to select the following advanced placement courses for college credit:

For the 2015-16 school year, we had a combined total of 194 AP students take 374 exams. 120 students (61.9%) earned a score of 3, 4, or 5 on these exams. For the 2016-17 school year, we had a combined total of 202 students take 387 AP exams. 141 students (69.8%) earned a score of 3, 4, or 5 on these exams, potentially leading to college credit or higher placement in college classes. For the 2017-18 school year, a total of 210 students take a combined total of 416 AP Exams with 76.7% of them earning a 3, 4, or 5 on the exams. This compares favorably to a state average of 64.8%. For the 2016-17 school year, we had 12 of 980 students dual enrolled, and for 2017-18 school year, 26 of 1038 students were dual enrolled. The number of students taking advantage of this option, continues to grow.

The coming years will continue to present many exciting challenges to South Lyon East High School Students. We will continue to establish new traditions, look for new ways to provide for student success, eliminate the achievement gap in sub groups, and enable our students to obtain an optimum educational experience. We thank our parents, business partners, and community for assisting us in providing an exceptional educational program at South Lyon East High School.
