

South Lyon Preschool Classes 2017-2018

Parent-Tot classes are designed for children to attend with their parent or another adult. The teacher leads parents and children in exploring new activities in art, storytelling, socialization, and physical activities. Children develop new skills and make new friends. Children do not need to be toilet-trained.

Preschool classes for 3-year-olds provide “hands on” experiences in science and art exploration, language development, and activities to develop large and small muscle coordination. The focus is to encourage the child to develop positive social habits such as: sharing, self-control, recognizing the rights of others, learning to adapt to group situations, and making new friends. We use the HighScope curriculum which is aligned with State of Michigan Standards of Quality for Preschool. All classes have a teacher and associate teacher. Children should be toilet-trained.

Our blended program is a class for 4-year-olds along with children from our Early Childhood Special Education program. This class features our HighScope curriculum. The class will have a preschool teacher and associate teacher along with a special education teacher and special education paraprofessional for a lower adult/child ratio. Tuition-based children should be toilet-trained.

Little Kids Club: This is our all-day preschool program for 3 and 4 year olds that runs from 8:30 am until 3:30 pm. Wrap around care is offered from 7:00 am until 6:00 pm. This program runs from September until June. This program also uses the HighScope curriculum. We provide a morning and afternoon snack as well as a licensing-required rest time. Parents send lunch. Children should be toilet-trained. Families using the program full-time are given a preference for registration.

Great Start Readiness Program: This is our state-funded program. Children and families must qualify primarily based on income. Example: A family of four with an income of \$61,500 could qualify. However, other risk factors are also considered. A completed application is required prior to beginning the interview process. Registration: A **non-refundable** registration fee of \$80.00 for the first child in the family or \$120.00 for 2 or more children is due at time of registration.

For new families, your registration and first payment must be made by check or cash. Current families can use their Tuition Express account to pay on-line.

Tuition: Current family tuition is payable in 9 installments beginning August 1 and each month through April 1 (August, September, October, November, December, January, February, March, April). Contact the office for information on 10 payments for D17-454.

For **new enrolling families**, the first payment is due at registration along with the registration fee and then follows the above schedule beginning with the September 1 payment. All fees are included in the tuition price.

Tuition Discount: Families paying the total tuition at registration (or by August 1) will receive a discount of 5% (registration fee not included in discount). Parent-Tot classes are not eligible for the tuition discount.

Timeline for changes and refunds:

August 15, 2017: Deadline for enrolled students to change classes without a fee (space permitting).

August 16 - 31, 2017: Enrolled students are assessed a fee of 3% of the tuition cost to switch classes (space permitting).

September 1, 2017: NO REFUNDS of 1st tuition payment.

September 2 through the first week of Preschool: Only the 2nd tuition payment (due September 1) will be refunded if a child is withdrawn from the program.

Monday of the 2nd week of Preschool: NO REFUNDS of any tuition payments.

September 5, 2017: No changes or class switching for enrolled children will be permitted. New students may be enrolled as space allows.

Miscellaneous Information: A **waiting list** will be created when a class fills. New classes may be created if space allows and at the discretion of the district.

Classes are **in session** for a total of 30 weeks times the number of days per week the class meets. Calendars for each class will be provided by the classroom teacher. Classes include field trips and special evening sessions. Generally classes meet from mid-September through May.

Classes may be **combined due to low enrollment**. Those enrolled in the affected classes will be given the choice to accept the combined class, another class with openings, or offered a refund.

All children (except Parent-Tot) should be **toilet-trained**.

Class Cancellations: This class schedule is subject to change and/or cancellation based on classroom availability and enrollment. Parents will be notified if a class is not available. Families enrolled in a cancelled class will be given the choice to choose another class with openings or given a refund.

Payment Information: Checks should be made to S.L.C.E. Payment can be made by cash in the Early Childhood Center office during office hours. After a Preschool account has been established you may pay on-line with a credit card. (Call the office for information regarding on-line payment set up)
