Preschool Class Descriptions

Parent-Tot Classes

Parent Tot classes are designed for children to attend with their parent or other adult. The teacher leads children in exploring new activities such as storytelling, socialization, and physical activities. Children develop new skills and make new friends. Children do **not** need to be toilet trained to attend.

Tot Classes

Tot classes are for children who are at least 30 months old. This class is similar to our Parent-Tot class but parents have the choice to either attend with their child or leave the child to have their first classroom experience independently.

Three Year Old Classes

Provide "hands on" experiences in science and art exploration, language development, and activities to develop large and small muscle coordination. The focus is to encourage the child to develop positive social habits such as sharing, self-control, recognizing the rights of others, learning to adapt to group situations and making new friends. We use the HighScope curriculum, which is aligned with the State of Michigan Standards of Quality for Preschool. All classes have a lead teacher and associate teacher. Children should be toilet trained.

Four Year Old Classes

Continue to focus on language, literature, writing, speaking, alphabetic principles, concepts of print, social development and emotional well-being, numbers and numeracy, exploration of science and nature, creative art activities, music and movement, small and large motor development and encouragement of critical thinking. Our HighScope curriculum is aligned with the South Lyon Schools Kindergarten curriculum. All classes have a lead teacher and an associate teacher. Children should be toilet trained.

All Day Pre-K Classes

Our all-day preschool programs for 3 and 4 year olds have preschool programming from 8:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. Monday - Friday. Wrap around care is offered from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. at no additional charge. This program runs the school year from September until June. We use the HighScope curriculum and provide a morning and afternoon snack as well as a licensing-required rest time. Parents provide lunch. Children should be toilet-trained.

Great Start Readiness

This is our state-funded program. Children and families must qualify primarily based on income. A family of four with an income of approximately \$61,000 could qualify. However, other risk factors are also considered. A completed application is required prior to beginning the interview process.
