

**SLCS Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan
Reconfirmation Meeting**

Required 30 Days After Initial Plan Approval and Every Month Thereafter

Reconfirmation Meeting for October 2020:

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Elementary (Grades JK - 5):

Elementary school students will continue in their current pathway- hybrid in-person/remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year. Students in the hybrid in-person/remote model are attending school four full days in-person on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. This group attends school remotely on Wednesdays.

No changes are recommended to the elementary mode of instruction.

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):

Middle school students will continue in their current pathway- hybrid in-person/remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year. Beginning October 12, 2020, all middle school students in the hybrid in-person/remote model began a hybrid model of in-person instruction as described below.

- October 12 - October 23: 25% of students (based on last name) attend in-person instruction, while the remaining 75% of students (based on last name) learn remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday). Wednesday is a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, will receive daily synchronous instruction in each class.
- Beginning October 26th: 50% of students (based on last name) attend in-person instruction, while the remaining 50% of students (based on last name) learn remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday). Wednesday is a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or

remotely at home, will receive daily synchronous instruction in each class.

No changes are recommended to the middle school mode of instruction at this time, as we have not yet begun the planned increase in daily attendance to approximately 50%. The district needs time to implement and evaluate the planned changes before any additional shifts will be considered.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

High school students will continue in their current pathway- hybrid in-person/remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year. Beginning October 12, 2020, all high school students in the hybrid in-person/remote model began a hybrid model of in-person instruction as described below.

- October 12 - October 23: 25% of students (based on last name) attend in-person instruction, while the remaining 75% of students (based on last name) learn remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday). Wednesday is a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, will receive daily synchronous instruction in each class.
- Beginning October 26th: 50% of students (based on last name) attend in-person instruction, while the remaining 50% of students (based on last name) learn remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday). Wednesday is a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, will receive daily synchronous instruction in each class.

No changes are recommended to the high school mode of instruction at this time, as we have not yet begun the planned increase in daily attendance to approximately 50%. The district needs time to implement and evaluate the planned changes before any additional shifts will be considered.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

All elementary students in the hybrid in-person/remote model are attending four full days of instruction each week.

At the secondary schools, some students have been invited to attend additional days beyond the one currently assigned day, based on individual needs.
