

**SLCS Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan
Reconfirmation Meeting**

Required 30 Days After Initial Plan Approval and Every Month Thereafter

Reconfirmation Meeting for November 2020:

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Elementary (Grades JK - 5):

Elementary school students will continue in their current pathway- Hybrid In-Person/Remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

Students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway are currently attending school four full days in-person on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. This group currently attends school remotely on Wednesdays.

Wednesday, November 18th will be a workday for teachers so they are able to prepare for transitions between remote and in-person learning. Below is the adjusted schedule to be followed through the remainder of November and through December.

- **11/19:** Full day in-person
- **11/20:** Half day in-person (AM only/Teacher Records Day)
- **11/23 & 11/24:** Full days in-person
- **11/25 - 11/27:** No school - Thanksgiving
- **11/30 - 12/18:** Remote Learning
- **12/21 - 1/1:** No school - Winter Break
- **1/4 - 1/8:** Remote Learning

When needed, in-person instruction (for classrooms or for schools) will be transitioned to remote in response to COVID-related needs or unforeseen circumstances.

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):

Middle school students will continue in their current pathway- hybrid in-person/remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

Middle school students in the hybrid in-person/remote pathway currently follow a plan in which 50% of students (based on last name) attend in-person instruction, while the remaining 50% of students (based on last name) learn remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday). Wednesday is a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, receive daily synchronous instruction in each class.

Beginning Thursday, November 19th, all middle school students in the hybrid in-person/remote pathway will shift to fully remote learning. Wednesday, November 18th will be a workday for teachers. The fully remote model will continue through at least January 8th, with a possible return on or after January 11th. When students return to in-person instruction, the 50% attendance model would be reinstated.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

High school students will continue in their current mode of instruction- Hybrid In-person/Remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

High school students in the Hybrid In-person/Remote Pathway currently follow a plan in which 50% of students (based on last name) attend in-person instruction, while the remaining 50% of students (based on last name) learn remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday). Wednesday is a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, receive daily synchronous instruction in each class.

Beginning Thursday, November 19th, all high school students in the Hybrid In-person/Remote Pathway will shift to fully remote learning. Wednesday, November 18th will be a workday for teachers. The fully remote model will continue through at least January 8th, with a possible return on or after January 11th. When students return to in-person instruction, the 50% attendance model would be reinstated.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

Programs that serve students with additional needs may be prioritized for an earlier return to in-person instruction.
