

**SLCS Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan
Reconfirmation Meeting**

Required 30 Days After Initial Plan Approval and Every Month Thereafter

Reconfirmation Meeting for December 2020:

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Elementary (Grades JK - 5):

Elementary school students will continue in their current pathway- Hybrid In-Person/Remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

Students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway are currently attending school remotely through January 8, 2021. Prior to shifting to remote instruction on November 30, 2020, students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway were attending school four full days in-person on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. During that time, this group attended school remotely on Wednesdays.

- **12/14 - 12/18:** Remote Learning
- **12/21 - 1/1:** No school - Winter Break
- **1/4 - 1/8:** Remote Learning

The Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway is scheduled to resume in-person instruction on January 11, 2021. We will follow the established format of four full days in-person on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesdays will continue to be fully remote.

When needed, in-person instruction (for classrooms or for schools) will be transitioned to remote in response to COVID-related or other unforeseen circumstances.

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):

Middle school students will continue in their current pathway- hybrid in-person/remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

Middle school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway are currently attending school remotely through January 8, 2021. Prior to shifting to remote instruction on November 19, 2020, middle school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway were following a plan in which 50% of students (based on last name) attended in-person instruction, while the remaining 50% of students (based on last name) learned remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday). Wednesday was a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, received daily synchronous instruction in each class.

- **12/14 - 12/18:** Remote Learning
- **12/21 - 1/1:** No school - Winter Break
- **1/4 - 1/8:** Remote Learning

The Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway is scheduled to resume in-person instruction on January 11, 2021. We will follow the established format as described above when in-person instruction resumes.

When needed, in-person instruction (for classrooms or for schools) will be transitioned to remote in response to COVID-related or other unforeseen circumstances.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

High school students will continue in their current mode of instruction- Hybrid In-person/Remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

Prior to shifting to remote instruction on November 19, 2020, high school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway were following a plan in which 50% of students (based on last name) attended in-person instruction, while the remaining 50% of students (based on last name) learned remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday). Wednesday was a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, received daily synchronous instruction in each class.

- **12/14 - 12/18:** Remote Learning

- **12/21 - 1/1:** No school - Winter Break
- **1/4 - 1/8:** Remote Learning
- **1/11 and beyond:** to be determined

The Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway is scheduled to resume in-person instruction on January 11, 2021. We will follow the established format as described above when in-person instruction resumes.

When needed, in-person instruction (for classrooms or for schools) will be transitioned to remote in response to COVID-related or other unforeseen circumstances.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

Programs that serve students with additional needs will be prioritized to the extent possible for an earlier return to in-person instruction.
