

**SLCS Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan
Reconfirmation Meeting**

Required 30 Days After Initial Plan Approval and Every Month Thereafter

Reconfirmation Meeting for February 2021:

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Elementary (Grades JK - 5):

Elementary school students will continue in their current pathway- Hybrid In-Person/Remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

Elementary students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway will continue utilizing a model which includes attending school four full days in-person on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. This group will attend school remotely on Wednesdays.

When needed, in-person instruction (for students, classrooms or schools) will be transitioned to remote in response to COVID-related or other unforeseen circumstances.

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):

Middle school students will continue in their current pathway- hybrid in-person/remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

Middle school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway are currently utilizing a model which includes 50% of students (based on last name) attending in-person instruction, while the remaining 50% of students (based on last name) learn remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday). Wednesday is a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, receive daily synchronous instruction in each class.

A transition period beginning on Monday, February 8th, will allow middle school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway to opt to attend the other two in-person instruction days in addition to their two regularly assigned in-person days.

Beginning on March 8th, all middle school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway will attend the four in-person instruction days unless they are quarantined or otherwise ill. Wednesday will continue to be a remote day for all Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway students.

When needed, in-person instruction (for students, classrooms or schools) will be transitioned to remote and/or the district may extend the transition period in response to COVID-related or other unforeseen circumstances.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

High school students will continue in their current mode of instruction- Hybrid In-person/Remote or the Virtual Learning Pathway. Students in the Virtual Learning Pathway will continue with 5 virtual learning days each week until the end of the school year.

High school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway are currently utilizing a model which includes 50% of students (based on last name) attending in-person instruction, while the remaining 50% of students (based on last name) learn remotely from home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday). Wednesday is a fully remote day for all students. All students, whether learning in-person or remotely at home, receive daily synchronous instruction in each class.

A transition period beginning on Monday, February 8th, will allow high school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway to opt to attend the other two in-person instruction days in addition to their two regularly assigned in-person days.

Beginning on March 8th, all high school students in the Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway will attend the four in-person instruction days unless they are quarantined or otherwise ill. Wednesday will continue to be a remote day for all Hybrid In-Person/Remote Pathway students.

When needed, in-person instruction (for students, classrooms or schools) will be transitioned to remote and/or the district may extend the transition period in response to COVID-related or other unforeseen circumstances.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

All elementary school students in the hybrid in-person/remote model will be attending four full days of instruction each week.

All middle and high school students have the opportunity to attend four in-person instructional days each week. This would include students who are English Language learners, have an IEP or 504, or are otherwise considered a special population.
