

2021-2022 SLCS Visitor Screening Guidelines

One of the strategies for reducing the spread of the COVID-19 virus is for people to remain at home if they are experiencing symptoms or if they have had close contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19. The series of questions that asks about an individual's health and possible exposures is called a screener. Visitors who attend South Lyon Community Schools are expected to complete a screener daily before entering a school.

Question 1

Have you tested positive for the COVID-19 virus within the last 10 days? *

Question 2

Are you currently experiencing ONE or more of the symptoms (listed below) unrelated to a known pre-existing condition (e.g. Asthma, Allergies)? *

New cough Shortness of breath Difficulty breathing New loss of taste or smell

Question 3

Are you currently experiencing TWO or more of the following symptoms (in the description below) unrelated to a known pre-existing condition (e.g. asthma, allergies)? *

Fever (100.4 degrees or greater), Chills, Diarrhea (2x in 24 hours), Congestion or runny nose, Nausea or vomiting (2x in 24 hours), Headache, Muscle aches, Sore throat, Fatigue

Question 4

Have you been within 3 feet of a person infected with the COVID-19 virus for a cumulative of 15 minutes or more starting from 2 days before the onset of the COV+ person's symptoms (or, for asymptomatic patients, 2 days before they tested)? *

If you answered "Yes" to any of the above questions do not enter the building.

If you answered "No" to all of the above questions, you may enter the building.
