Dear South Lyon Community Schools COMMUNITY,

COVID-19 is a respiratory disease caused by SARS-CoV-2 virus. The virus is thought to spread mainly from person to person through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks. Some people who are infected may not have symptoms. For people who have symptoms, illness can range from mild to severe.

Quarantining helps to prevent the spread of COVID-19. When our district is informed that a person has tested positive with the virus, South Lyon Community Schools assists Oakland County Health Department in contact tracing. Those persons who have been identified as close contacts are required to quarantine. Those individuals who are fully vaccinated or have tested positive within the last three months are exempt from the quarantine requirement.

The cases identified today are a reminder that the preventative measures such as frequent hand washing, wearing facial coverings, and maintaining social distancing (when possible) are necessary. COVID-19 es una enfermedad respiratoria causada por el virus del SARS-CoV-2. Se cree que el virus se transmite principalmente de persona a persona a través de gotas respiratorias que se producen cuando una persona infectada tose, estornuda o habla. Es posible que algunas personas infectadas no presenten síntomas. Para las personas que tienen síntomas, la enfermedad puede variar de leve a grave.

La cuarentena ayuda a prevenir la propagación de COVID-19.
