Middle School ACADEMICALLY TALENTED PROGRAM ELA Honors & MATH PLUS

2024-2025

The screening process for the 2024-2025 ELA Honors and Math PLUS programs is beginning for current 6th graders.

The ELA Honors and Math PLUS Programs are available at both Centennial and Millennium Middle Schools and currently consist of 1-2 classes of ELA and 1-2 classes of Math, at each grade level. These classes have been designed to challenge those students who are performing at least one year above grade level and whose academic needs cannot be met with the regular, differentiated curriculum.

Current middle school students may be nominated for these programs for next year:

• 6th graders for Math 7 PLUS and/or ELA 7 Honors

Parents may nominate their child for the Honors/PLUS Program screening. Parents will first need to discuss this with their child's Math or ELA teacher to determine if the student is currently functioning above grade level, has a need for instruction beyond the regular, differentiated curriculum and could be successful in the Honors/PLUS Program. A student who is receiving an "A" grade in the regular, on-grade level curriculum does not necessarily have a need for, nor should be, automatically placed in a PLUS class.

Nominated students must have:

- All A's in the subject (ELA or Math)
- NWEA scores 85% or above for 2022 & 2023

Nominated students will be evaluated by the Academically Talented Program Committee and may need to take several above grade level tests as an additional portion of the screening process.

If you wish to nominate your child, you must fill out and submit the online form by Friday, December 15, 2023. PLEASE NOTE: If your student is already in an ELA Honors or Math PLUS class, they do not need to be screened or tested for next year. They will automatically be placed in the next accelerated class.
