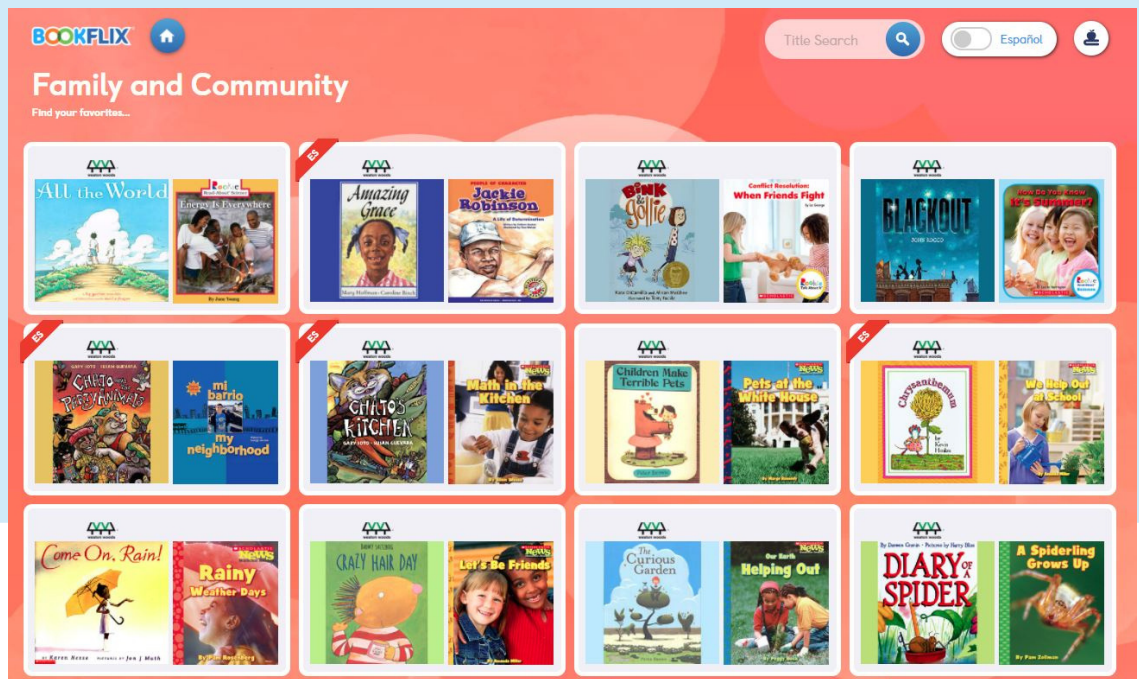


# LTPL PROUDLY PRESENTS A NEW ONLINE RESOURCE: BOOKFLIX, BY SCHOLASTIC



What is Bookflix? It's an online literacy resource that pairs classic video storybooks from Weston Woods with related nonfiction from Children's Press and other trusted Scholastic imprints. This engaging resource for children in grades pre-K through 3 will help early readers develop and practice essential reading skills and introduce them to a world of knowledge and exploration.

All the fiction/nonfiction pairs in BookFlix are categorized according to nine themes: Animals and Nature; Earth and Sky; Family and Community; People and Places; Music and Rhyme; ABC's and 1, 2, 3's; Adventure; Imagination; and Celebrations. From the Home page, click on one of the nine themes to browse the pairs in each category. Pairs are listed in alphabetical order by story title.

BookFlix is perfect for use in small-group rotations in the classroom. Teachers may use the lesson plan that accompanies each pair as a starting point for ideas.
